

> Adult Centre ages 18+ (Sliema, Malta)



The main school, which is for adults aged 18 upwards, is located in the lively seaside commercial town of Sliema, just a 20 minute bus ride away from Malta's capital city, Valletta. St. Julian's, one of the island's most popular nightlife areas is only, 15 minutes away along the promenade.

This modern centre is air-conditioned throughout and boasts bright and well equipped classrooms, a bookshop,

an internet café, Wi-Fi access in the reception area, a cafeteria and vending machines with snacks and drinks. There is also a self-access centre offering a selection of books and multi-media software free of charge. There are 100 classrooms enabling a maximum capacity of 690 students. All regular group courses have a maximum of 12 students, whereas mini groups have a maximum of 6 students per class.



False Beginners

Student will have a basic knowledge of the language and understands and uses familiar everyday expressions and simple phrases.

> Elementary CEF A1

Student can understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type. Can introduce him/herself and others and can ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people he/she knows and things he/she has. Can interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.

Pre-Intermediate CEF A2

Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment). Can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters. Can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.

Intermediate CEF B1

Can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc. Can deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken. Can produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest. Can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.

CFF B2

Upper intermediate Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in his/her field of specialisation. Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party. Can produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

Advanced CEF C1

Can understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts, and recognise implicit meaning. Can express him/herself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions. Can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes. Can produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organisational patterns, connectors and cohesive devices.



General English

The General English Course aims to improve your competence in general English. The course provides systematic practice in the four main areas of language learning: reading, writing, speaking and listening.

The first session concentrates on stabilising and improving present knowledge of grammar and vocabulary. The second session is fluency based with the objective of improving communication skills and helping students to gain confidence in spoken English.

> Beginners' English





- Students need to have an Intermediate level of English and are required to book at least a 4 week General English course at IELS.
- After completing their course of English Language study at IELS, the students are then placed in a company for a minimum of 12 weeks.

Cambridge Exam Courses

Key English Test (KET) (CEF A2 – Pre-intermediate)

KET is the Cambridge ESOL's exam which recognises the ability to deal with everyday written and spoken English at a basic level.

KET is a truly international certificate, recognised by administrative, industrial, and service-based employers as a qualification in intermediate English. It is also accepted by many educational institutions for study purposes. Companies such as Epson, Nestlé, Motorola and KPMG all recognise the value of KET in their overseas offices

Preliminary English Test (PET) (CEF B1 - Intermediate)

PET is an exam for people who can use everyday written and spoken English at an intermediate level. A PET certificate is valid for life. You will not need to take the exam again. It is truly an international certificate, recognised around the world for business and study purposes. Thousands of employers, universities and government departments officially recognise PET as an intermediate qualification in English. Although PET is a basic exam, it offers a chance to find out your strengths and weaknesses in using English, and gives you a pathway to higher qualifications such as the First Certificate in English (FCE).

The lessons are structured to focus on grammar and vocabulary building, with specific focus on the skills and knowledge needed for the examination. Students can expect to be given comprehensive practice of past papers and a thorough education in exam techniques. It should be noted that there is an expectation that the students have a certain degree of homework in order to prepare them fully for the exams.

> Exam Preparation Courses

IELTS Exam Course

This course is for students who are seeking to communicate effectively in everyday situations and gain a sound understanding of the principles of the English language.

The students also study exam techniques and exam preparation in a course specifically designed to suit their individual needs. Students wishing to attend university or colleges of higher education in English speaking countries would be expected to have an IELTS qualification before being accepted on a course. For this reason this course will prove invaluable to their preparation for taking the exam. Students attend 30 lessons per week for 8 weeks prior to the examination. In some instances, it is necessary to book an extra week of accommodation due to the exam date

TOEFL Preparation

This course prepares students for the TOEFL Internetbased Test by presenting and practicing strategies to help improve the students' reading, vocabulary, listening, speaking and writing skills. This course is beneficial for students who need a TOEFL score to get into a university in the USA, UK, Australia, New Zealand and Canada, that rely on TOEFL scores for admissions, scholarship and graduation decisions. Courses begin during the last week of every month and are of a duration of 4 weeks. During some months, the exam will take place upon completion of the course. However, there is also the possibility of students having to book an extra week accommodation since the exam date may change at the discretion of the examination centre.

> University Pathway Programme

The University Pathway Programme is ideal for students wishing to read for a Bachelor or a Masters degree at the University of Malta or at St. Martins Institute of IT. As part of the programme we will assist you in your application to enter University, at the same • IELTS 5.5 time helping you to achieve the IELTS level required for university entry.

In order to qualify for the University Pathway Programme, one must have an Intermediate level of English. The programme consists of 16 or 24 weeks of General English (20 lessons per week) followed by another 8 weeks of IELTS preparation (30 lessons per week).

Requirements for **IELS University Pathway Programme:**

- Evidence of current English language level. This will determine how long you need to spend at IELS to achieve the required IELTS level
- Copies of academic transcripts and qualifications required for UoM courses.

Entry requirements to the University of Malta Foundation Year:

High School Diploma

Note: if you have not received your diploma then conditional offers may be issued on the basis of transcripts of the last three years at High School obtained at the time of application.

- The appropriate University Entrance Examination
- Progression to the Bachelors degree is generally guaranteed (except for courses with limited entry) subject to successful completion of the Foundation course and obtaining the results required for the chosen undergraduate course.

Entry requirements to the University of Malta Masters degrees:

- Qualifications deemed to be equivalent to a Second Class Bachelor Honours Degree
- IELTS 6.5

Note: Applicants holding an Ordinary Bachelor degree or a lower class in an Honours degree from a recognised and accredited university, together with IELTS 6.0, may gain access to the Masters Qualifying Year, successful completion of which guarantees access to a Masters degree.

University of Malta

Conscious of its public role, the University strives to create courses which are relevant and timely in response to the needs of the country. There are some 10,000 students including over 750 foreign/exchange students from nearly 80 different countries, following full-time or part-time degree and diploma courses, many of them run on the modular or credit system.

The University is geared towards the infrastructural and industrial needs of the country so as to provide expertise in crucial fields. Over 2,500 students graduate in various disciplines annually. The degree courses at the University are designed to produce highly qualified professionals, with experience of research, who will play key roles in industry, commerce and public affairs in general.

Applications for courses at the University of Malta starting in October 2010 will be accepted as from 1st October 2009. The deadline for applications for most courses will be 15th May 2010. The University has introduced an online application

St Martins Institute of IT

St. Martin's Institute of Information Technology is the primary provider of Information Systems, Computing and Business Education in Malta. The Institute was set up in 1985, and since then has been preparing students for competitive and public examinations in these subjects, based upon syllabi offered by renowned British and Maltese Universities.

The Institute, together with a number of similar institutions worldwide, provides tuition based upon the University of London and offers tuition support for degrees led by Goldsmiths and London School of Economics and Political Science, both Colleges of the University of London. Students have the unique opportunity to study and complete a university degree in Malta whilst being registered as an external student of the University of London.

Applications open on 1st November 2009 and close on 30th June 2010. Students are required to apply for the course with an application form, details of qualifications, as well as their IELTS result. The minimum entry requirement for diploma students is IELTS 5.0 or equivalent. Students who want to apply for degrees are required to have an IELTS score of 6.0 and a minimum level of 5.5 in each sub-test.


Nightlife in Malta is diverse and exciting with places of interest within nearly every major tourist area.
